

## **Student Research Summary**

## Submission Guidelines

Please provide a summary of the research project you are working on (either in progress or has been completed in 2024) using the following format:

- Project title
- Student name, affiliation (University & department) and contact details (email and phone numbers)
- Student supervisor(s)
- When the research was (will be) completed
- Research objective
- Problems or questions you are trying to address
- How your research will benefit the water industry
- Findings to date
- Papers arising from the work that have been published to date

The submission should include a graphical presentation of the topic, where possible, to depict, for example, the R&D objectives, present key results etc.

The submission should have a word count of approximately 250-500 words and be contained within one A4 page (including graphs, figures, etc). Text should be presented in single spaced, size 11 Arial font.

Would this be a special issue on students' summaries, or would a few be published in a number of different issues of the journal?

Would the Student Research Summary need to undergo peer review?

• No. It is not the intention for these summaries to be considered as per reviewed manuscripts. Hence they will not be subject to the usual peer review process

May I submit a full paper?

 Absolutely! This can be done in addition to or instead of the Student Research Summary. Papers should be submitted via <u>Scholastica</u>. Please note that full papers will undergo the usual peer review process required by the association.
