



GUY PARKER AWARD



Eligibility

- Anyone can submit a paper to the [Water e-Journal](#). You do not need to be a member of the Australian Water Association.
- Open to AWA members and non-members
- Open to an individual, group of individuals, or organisation

Criteria

The judging for the Guy Parker award will be based on the following criteria:

1. Contribution to Knowledge

Technical Papers should be scholarly in style and formally structured and aimed at an audience that can comprehend scientific, technical and economic arguments. Authors should bear in mind the multidisciplinary audience, so papers should avoid the most arcane aspects of a topic. Papers may describe substantial improvements of existing theories or present new data in support and extension of these theories.

Comparative or supportive data must be included.

2. Technical and Case Study Content

The paper must detail the objectives of the project and the general procedures/ methodology. The quality of the technical content must be high and for case studies sound analysis of the issue, detailed solution and thorough analysis of the outcome must be demonstrated.

3. Interest and Significance to the audience

Actual benefits and applications should be reported. Papers that have been presented previously at a conference or in a journal and presentations of a commercial or marketing nature should show originality to differentiate the paper.

4. Quality and Presentation

Authors should have prepared their full paper with care, using the technical paper submission template. Text should be clear, no spelling/ grammatical errors, feature high quality figures and tables, high quality method, results and discussion sections.
